# Topic

In this week's podcast, we discussed the role of gaming in the mission field. In today's small group we are looking into the concept of mission as a whole; specifically into the Great Commission.

Question 1:

Question 2:

Question 3:

#### Question 4:

What do you think regular mission work does for the individual? For their relationship with Christ, their perspective on the world, the change in their mindset, etc.

Question 5:

What can you start regularly doing in your community that is mission minded?
